Cesario General Instructions:

- Please use the provided FJM measurement forms.
- List male and female measurements on separate pages. They are sized by different standards; this will help avoid sizing errors.
- Please list all percussionists (battery and pit) on separate male and female pages marked "percussion." See percussion notes below.
- Schools or groups that will use uniforms for maturing members should measure some out-going older teenagers to ensure mature inventory sizes for the future.
- If possible, type the names and measurements into Excel (soft-copy) versions of the forms. This will help reduce errors by avoiding a re-typing for inventory and size assignments. Return a soft copy via email to your FJM sales rep.
- Please list all drum majors on a separate sheet **if** they are receiving unique uniforms.

MEASURING INSTRUCTIONS ALL STUDENTS:

1. Have students wear lightweight clothing when being measured: allow no sweaters or bulky clothing that might distort measurements.
2. Keep the measuring tape straight and against the body – **but not tight** – do not add or take inches away.
3. Assign one or two people to do all the measuring; this should ensure better consistency.
4. Measure according to the instructions and diagram below:

CHEST – measure around the entire circumference of the fullest part of the chest. **A-B -A**

uniform accessories

WAIST – measure the ENTIRE circumference of the natural waistline.

C- D - C

HIPS – measure 7 inches down from the waist and then measure the entire circumference of the hips. **E-F-E**

HEIGHT AND WEIGHT – Use a tape measure for accurate height measurement. Use a scale for accurate weight measurement. Measure a person's height from the top of the head to the floor with no shoes being worn.

WRIST – Place your index finger over the person's wrist and measure around both the wrist and the finger. This represents a more accurate measurement to fit a gauntlet to be worn over a jacket.

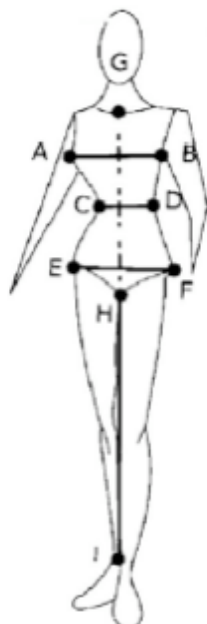

PERCUSSION

TWO measurements are required for **snare and tenor players**:

1. **With harness measured as described above.**
2. **Without harness measured as described above.**

- Bass drum players do not require these measurements since they are unable to wear a jacket over the carrier.
- It is assumed, unless otherwise noted on your Percussion Measurement Sheets, that percussion-style gauntlets will be manufactured for **all** percussion members.
- **If you do not require percussion-style gauntlets for all of your percussion members please mark a "P" by those members that WILL need them.**
