- ALL FEES MUST BE PAID AND ALL FORMS COMPLETED
AND TURNED IN OR STUDENT WILL NOT BE GOING ON TRIP**
- Trip updates will be posted on the web

- Don't bring valuable items—no liability insurance
- Pool at hotel
- Two security guards to patrol each floor at night
- Be sure to have hat, sunglasses and sun block
- 24 parent chaperones to be treated with respect at all times
- Mr. P responsible for all discipline
- Bring proper clothes as representing school, community and self
- Will search luggage if necessary but prefer parents to search prior to trip
- Students limited to one piece of luggage under bus & one on bus
- Pack concert gowns neatly in suitcase
- Fairfax County rules apply in Disney World
- Room check at 11:00 p.m.
- Doors will be taped. If broken, student will be on the next plane home.
- Check on-line itinerary
- Leaving Wednesday, March 21 at 8:00 p.m. Arrive at school at 7:00 p.m.
- Students responsible for loading their instruments
 - Small, i.e., flute/clarinet should be packed in luggage
 - Medium, i.e., sax/horns will go under the bus
 - Large, i.e., tuba/bass clarinet will go in truck
- Students responsible for packing music
- Meals covered except for Thursday students pay for meals
- At Disney students will receive park hopper pass and card with \$25.00 food allowance
- Lost park hopper pass can be replaced but NOT meal card
- PARENTS—ask your student who his/her group leader is
- All students are to be in groups of 4 or more, never alone
- Have change of clothes, deodorant, tooth brush and toothpaste in backpack for Thurs a.m. arrival because luggage stays under bus until arrival at hotel Thursday night
- Friday performances
 - All should have a change of clothes with them
 - Jazz first in jazz clothes with concert uniform with them
 - Other ensembles perform between 3:30 and 7:00 p.m.

 - Keep comfortable clothes in backpack on bus for trip home
